

Information Guide For Solicitors

Including a Gift in Will to Baptist World Aid Australia

To ensure your client's gift has the greatest impact, we recommend they leave a **general gift**, rather than requesting to direct its use. This allows Baptist World Aid Australia flexibility to direct the gift to where the need is greatest at the time.

A **residual gift** is the best way of ensuring the Will provides for family and loved ones first.

SUGGESTED WORDING

Residual Gift

I give the rest and residue of my estate to the Baptist World Aid Australia Public Ancillary Fund.
And I declare that a receipt issued from the Proper Officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my executor or trustee for the said gift and my executor or trustee shall not be bound to see the application thereof.

% Residual Gift

I give ___ percent of the rest and residue of my estate to the Baptist World Aid Australia Public Ancillary Fund.

And I declare that a receipt issued from the Proper Officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my executor or trustee for the said gift and my executor or trustee shall not be bound to see the application thereof.
